### B. <u>Developing a competitive team:</u>


The effectiveness in developing a competitive team is measured by wins and losses.

#### C. Developing the Program:

The effectiveness of a development program to sustain excellence in the sport is demonstrated when:

- 2. Assistant coaches articulate and communicate Jenison Christian's and the Head Coach's purpose for athletes in that sport.
- 3. Assistant coaches have prepared the student-athletes to participate competitively at the next level.
- 4. The Head Coach can say the assistant coaches are supportive of and an integral part of the program.
- 5. Parents understand and accept Jenison Christian's purpose for athletics, the specific sport's philosophy, the team selection process, and the results a student athlete will accomplish by participating in the sport.
